origin:	South Africa	bloom season:	Winter
hardiness:	20° F	deer tolerance:	high
watering:	monthly once established, drought tolerant		

This UC Santa Cruz introduction has a compact growth habit and deep and vibrant red-wine coloration in the inflorescence and foliage during the colder winter months. While many leucadendron can grow quite large, this scaled-down cultivar is well-suited to pots, xeriscape borders in a smaller garden or even mass mid-ground plantings in a larger landscape. Its winter coat is truly stunning and the year-round deer and drought tolerance are well suited to the mediterranean garden.
